### PROGRAM

Burt Dibble, the GSE team leader and Maria Andrea, a GSE team member, spoke about their trip to Hong Kong, Macau, and Mongolia. They were part of a six person team that traveled overseas last year visiting Rotary District 3450.

The team was different from most GSE teams because all the members were from the medical community. It included two physicians, two registered nurses, one social worker and one physical therapist. The trip started out in Hong Kong where they found well developed and organized medical care, modeled more on the western style of medicine (due to Great Britain's influence). Even though medical care is well developed in Hong Kong, they found that there continues to be Chinese herbal medicine being used and being integrated with modern medical practices.

After leaving Hong Kong they took a one hour boat ride to Macau, which Maria described as the Las Vegas of China. They interacted with other health care providers and were able to view such things as outdoor exercise equipment for ordinary citizens to use.

Following Macau, they flew to Mongolia, which is a cold climate and where the population is very proud of their warrior culture. The medical care is less well developed than in Hong Kong or Macau and one is not likely to find as much sophisticated medical treatment as in the other two cities. Maria mentioned that at one children's hospital they visited, the ratio of staff to patient was 1 to 20. A far cry from the Seacoast's leading medical center.

Burt ended the program by reminding the club that a GSE team is a District project and is designed for non-Rotarians between the ages of 25 and 40. The team is headed by a Rotarian and is meant to give the team members exposure to other cultures and business practices (in this case, all medical practices).

Our own **Phil Rinaldi** has been a GSE team leader, so if you want more specific information on the whole experience, speak with **Phil**.
